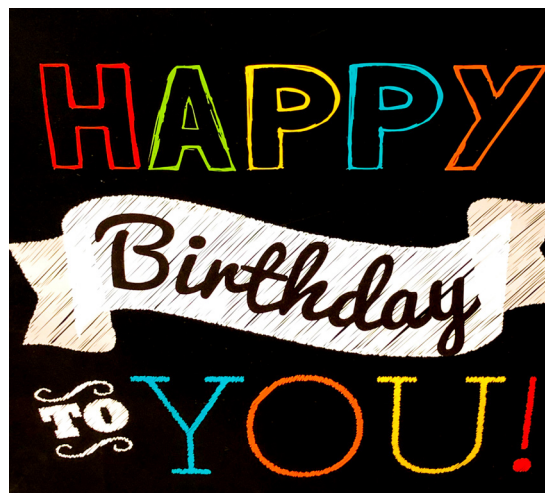

Notes from IT

Keep Your Smartphone Safe

Don't invite intruders into your smartphone and allow them to have access to your personal information stored there. Be wary of connecting your phone to public Wi-Fi. It's great when coffee shops, hospitals, or stores offer "free Wi-Fi," but if you decide to use it, avoid logging in to sensitive accounts such as your bank. Cyber criminals can potentially view everything you do on your phone while you are connected. To protect yourself from inadvertently using insecure Wi-Fi networks, adjust your phone settings to avoid auto-connecting to Wi-Fi.

Installing applications to your smartphone adds functionality but also increases the risk of a data breach, especially if you download them from a website rather than an app store. Keep in mind that neither Google nor Apple looks through every single app on their site to determine if it is malicious or not. Pay attention to warnings before you choose to download and install untrusted content.
