

Notes from IT

Is Your Smartphone Listening?

You've heard the rumors - are they true? Is your smartphone really listening to you?

The truth is, yes, your smartphone probably is listening. Want to make sure your phone is only listening when you want it to? Below are steps to turn your phone's microphone on and off in various apps.

Steps to check microphone access on your iPhone:

- Go to Settings
- Select Privacy
- Select Microphone (you will see a list of your apps with a slide to turn microphone on and off)


Steps to check microphone access on your Android phone:

- Go to Settings
- Select Applications
- Select Applications Manager (you will see a list of your apps with a slide to turn microphone on and off)

For iPhone users who are using older than IOS 13.1, your camera and microphone were probably turned on when an app or website needed it, and they remained on until you turned it off.

IOS 13.1 is more powerful when it comes to your privacy. It will ask you to choose which websites can access what kinds informations on your iPhone.

Suggestion: Turn off the microphone for all apps, and then, when you need it, manually turn it on.
