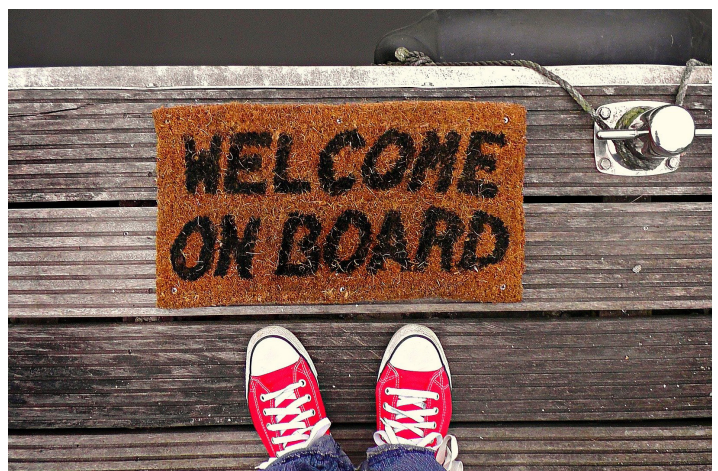

Georgia-Pacific representatives visited Station 8 to present the grant check, learn about the department's operations, and meet some of the county's volunteer firefighters.



Oconee County Water Resources recently received a Carolinas Design-Build Award and a Merit Award from the Associated Builders and Contractors of the Carolinas for the Calls Creek Water Reclamation Facility. The award was presented at the 2019 Excellence in Construction Awards Gala in November in Charlotte.
