Best Practices for Cleaning Your Tech

You probably have been eating at your desk more than usual due to our current circumstances, so here are some handy tips to help you clean up.

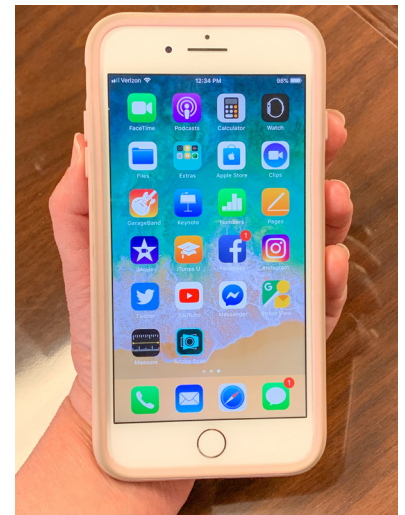
Keyboard & Mouse

- Shake to knock loose any debris and use compressed air
- Keep moisture to a minimum and don't use harsh chemicals or any type of bleach
- If your barbeque sauce isn't budging, use a disinfectant wipe
- Dry it off when finished with a microfiber cloth

Cell Phone & Monitor

- Use a dry microfiber cloth
- You can use soapy water sparingly on your microfiber cloth, but dry it afterwards
- Avoid getting excess moisture around ports or buttons (try a Q-tip)
- DON'T use compressed air
