
Notes from IT

New Features in iOS 14 for iPhone

The latest iPhone update has a number of helpful features that you may want to take advantage of - I've listed a few of my favorites below:

- Home Screen Redesign – Customize small, medium, or large widgets to display the information that is most important to you. You might choose the Weather, Calendar, News, Stock Market, etc. The widgets can be stacked so you can swipe up or down for more information.
- App Library – Your iPhone groups your applications automatically by category. From the home screen, swipe right until you get to your App Library.
- Minimized Call Screen – When someone calls you it no longer dominates your screen. It compresses the call at the top, so you can view it while keeping your current display in full view.
- Pin Conversations – Important conversations can be pinned to the top of the Messages app, which keeps them accessible. Up to nine conversations can be pinned in Messages.
- Translate App – (my personal favorite) Displays both languages on a split screen, where you can text or speak what you need translated. Supported languages – Arabic, Chinese, English, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish.
- Privacy – Apple is making it clearer what info apps collect, requiring more user permission, and providing ways to use location features without providing specific location data.
- Default Apps – Third-party mail and browser apps can be set as your default. So, now you can choose Chrome to be your default browser instead of Safari.

There are many more new features in iOS 14. Check them out and let me know your favorites! -Paula
