





Notes from IT Change Your Password!

On Monday, March 1, you will be instructed to change your network password. It is very important to change passwords at least annually, or when you suspect you've been compromised.



Once you log on to your computer with your username, press the CTRL+ALT+DEL keys. A blue screen will appear with several options. One of those options is "Change Password." Once you've selected that option, the following will display:

- OCBOC\your username
- Old password (enter your current password)
- New password (must be 6 characters long and meet three of the following four criteria: capital letter, lowercase letter, number, special character)
- Confirm password (re-enter new password from above)

Please note that when you change your password on your computer, you will also need to change it on your other devices that have your county email.

For iPhone & iPad:

- Go to Settings, Mail, Accounts
- Select Exchange, select your county email
- Change your password
