


Notes from IT Report Phishing Email



Help keep our network safe by reporting suspicious email! The Phish Alert button should be located on your ribbon in Outlook as shown in the picture above. If you have received a suspicious email which asks you to click a link or open an attachment, STOP, LOOK, and THINK.

STOP – Don't click a link or open an attachment without verification.


LOOK – Do you recognize the email address? Is it asking for personally identifiable information?

THINK – Was this an expected email?

To report a phishing email, click the Phish Alert Button. It will send IT an email, so that we can block that email address.
