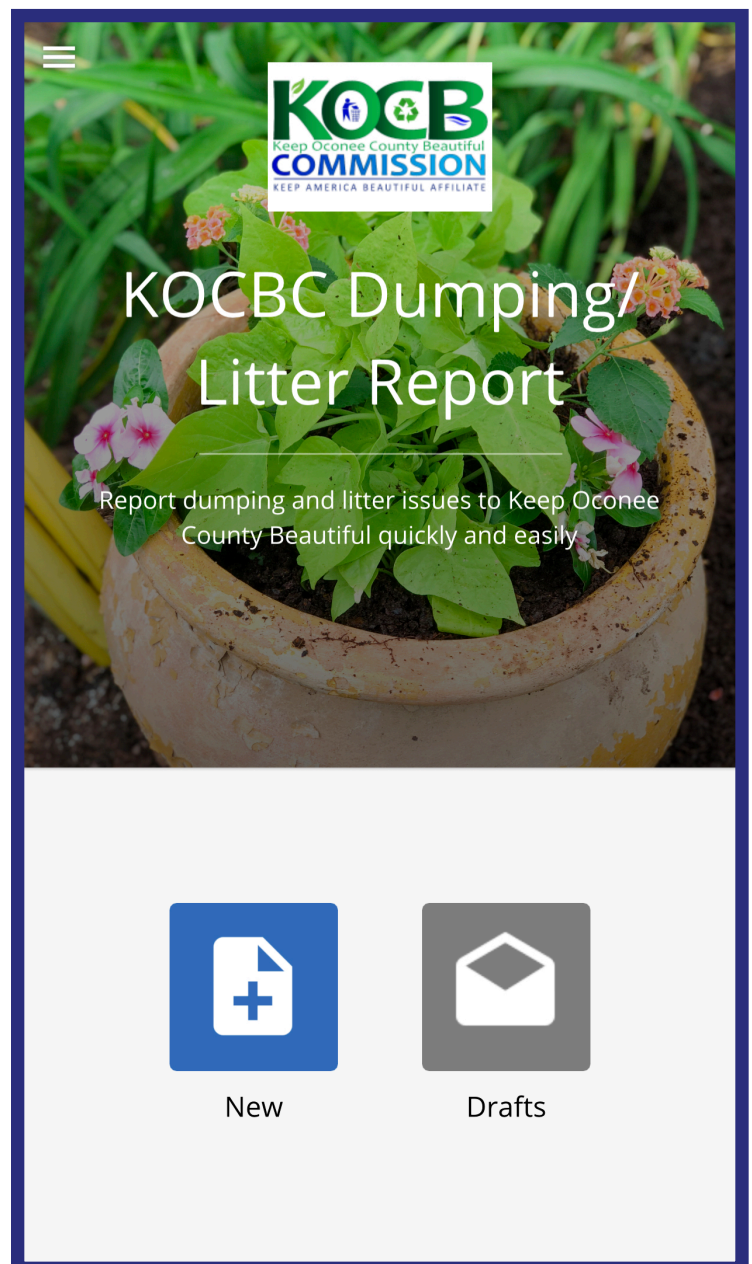
KOCBC Introduces New Dumping/Litter Reporting App

The Keep Oconee County Beautiful Commission has launched a new custom mobile app allowing anyone to quickly and easily report littering issues in the county.

Available for iOS devices on the Apple App Store, the “KOCBC Dumping/Litter Report” allows users to drop a pin at their location, select a category to describe the litter issue, upload a photo or video, and add comments to their report. Reports will be sent to Keep Oconee County Beautiful, Code Enforcement, the Road Department, and the Litter Patrol.

This app was developed in collaboration with Keep Oconee County Beautiful, GIS, and Communications.

Notes from IT

KnowBe4 Training Time

It's that time of year when we dive into cybersecurity awareness training. If you have a county email, you will receive an invitation to start your training. This online course is crucial to helping you protect our county network.

The Department of Homeland Security recently posted, "Every organization in the U.S. is at risk of a Russian cyberattack."

Users inside of a network can be the weakest link by not paying close attention and clicking on malicious emails, links, and attachments. Our organization is protected with a firewall, email filter, and anti-malware software, but cybercriminals can still get inside our systems by sending enticing emails that trick us into giving up information.

If you receive a suspicious email, don't forget to click on your Phish Alert button which sends that email to internal IT. Then, IT can block that user in our email filter.

Don't forget to STOP, LOOK & THINK.
