



Notes from IT: Phishing Warning Signs

Even the most carefully constructed phishing email usually has one or more giveaways if you look closely enough. The following are some signs that a message may be a phishing attempt:

Sender's address – If the email address used by the sender does not match the name of the organization implied by the email, or if it is misspelled or otherwise does not make sense in the context of the message, this may be a sign of a phishing email.

Grammar or spelling mistakes – Phishing emails often contain spelling or grammatical errors.

Odd formatting – Phishing emails may deviate from the standard formatting you would expect, such as using odd fonts or spacing.

Suspicious links – Phishing emails usually use links that appear to be genuine, but are not. For example, a fraudulent email might use a misspelling of “Bank of America” such as bankoffamerica.com.

Attachments – Attachments to email messages can contain ransomware or viruses. Be careful about opening any unfamiliar file types.

Sense of urgency – If you receive an email that makes you feel pressured to take immediate action, such as transferring money or providing sensitive information, you may have received a phishing email. This is often done to get you to overlook other warning signs.
