New IT HelpDesk System



In order to make it easier for you to report any IT issues, we have set up a dedicated helpdesk email address that you can use to contact us.

From now on, for any IT problems or requests, you can simply email ochelpdesk@oconee.ga.us. The IT department will receive your message and work to resolve the issue as soon as possible.

When you send an email to ochelpdesk@oconee.ga.us, it generates a support ticket in our system. This allows us to track and manage all requests more efficiently, ensuring that we are able to provide timely updates and resolution to your issues. You can communicate back and forth with the IT team by replying to ticket emails, which helps us to keep all information related to your request in one place.

We understand that IT issues can be frustrating and can impact your ability to perform your work effectively. That is why we are committed to providing you with the best possible support. Our helpdesk system allows us to manage requests more efficiently, ensuring that we are able to address your needs in a timely manner.
