
Employee Holiday Committee

Thomas Farms Preserve Now Open

The City of Watkinsville celebrated the opening of Thomas Farms Preserve on December 14. The new park is located just inside the city limits along Simonton Bridge Road, includes more than 1/3 of a mile of frontage along Calls Creek, more than 60 acres of open pasture, 33 acres of woodlands, and two ponds.

Bring One for the Chipper

Keep Oconee County Beautiful (KOCBC) is sponsoring Bring One for the Chipper 2024 now through the end of January as part of a statewide effort to recycle Christmas trees. Drop-off for undecorated, live trees will be at all five Oconee County Waste and Recycling Sites until January 4 during regular business hours. We will have tree saplings and seed packets on January 4. If you take your tree down later than the January 4, please take the tree to the Hwy 441 location for the month of January.

This annual event continues 30 years of tradition of actively participating in environmental education and stewardship by providing drop-off points in the community. The Christmas trees are recycled by chipping them into mulch for use in landscaping, or by using them as fish or animal habitats.
