How to Change Your Voicemail

Did you know that setting up or changing voicemail on your desk phone can be done with minimal IT assistance? Here's a quick guide to get you started.

1. Access Voicemail

Pick up your desk phone and push the voicemail button (The cassette tape image for new models or the envelope image for older models).

2. Enter PIN

When prompted, enter your 4 digit PIN. If you have forgotten the PIN or need a new one please email the ochelpdesk@oconee.ga.us to have someone in IT assist in setting up a new PIN.

3. Navigate Voicemail to Change Name

To change your "Recorded Name"
(The name you hear when you first dial your PIN)

Dial 4 for "Set Up Options"

Dial 3 for "Preferences"

Dial 2 for "Recorded Name" and say your name at the tone. Save the recording once you're satisfied by hitting pound (#).

4. Set Your Voicemail Greetings

To change your voicemail greetings repeat step 1 and step 2, then:

Dial 4 for "Set Up Options"

Dial 1 for "Greeting"

(This is where the phone will play the current voicemail you have set up, you will need to only update the "Standard Greeting" for the main voicemail, but you can choose others)

Dial 1 to record a new greeting at the tone. Once you are done hit the pound (#) to finish.

5. Test Your Voicemail

Call your desk phone from another line, leave a message, and check that your greeting plays and the voicemail works.

If these steps do not work and the voicemail is not updating please reach out to IT for assistance. We are happy to help!
