

Happy June from the IT Department!

As our new fiscal year kicks off, you may find yourself in more virtual meetings. Here's a quick refresher on screensharing in Microsoft Teams (similar tips apply for Zoom and Webex!). Please use our Scribe tutorial (linked below) alongside these steps to assist you.

After joining your meeting from the Calendar view, click the Share icon at the top-right of your window.

You'll see a few options under **Presenter Mode**:

Content only — shows just your screen.

Standout, Side-by-side, and Reporter — show your video alongside your content.

Choosing What to Share:

Screen — shares your entire screen, great if you're switching between apps (but double-check for any sensitive information first!).

Window — shares only one program (like a PowerPoint), perfect when you won't need to swap around.
