## Tire and Battery Amnesty



The Summer Oconee County Battery & Tire Amnesty event will run from July 2 through July 30.

Drop-off for this event is available **only at the Highway 441 Waste & Recycling Site**, located at 2721 Macon Highway/US 441 (former landfill site). Batteries and tires will be accepted during normal operating hours on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

### Tire Drop-Off Rules:

- Open to Oconee County residents only
- Limit of 4 tires per vehicle
- No businesses permitted – residential use only
- Only car and light truck tires without rims will be accepted

### Battery Recycling:

- Automotive and boat batteries accepted
- No quantity limit on batteries
