# Comms Corner

Welcome to the Communications Corner – let's talk accessibility in Adobe PDF.

Creating accessible documents isn't just about compliance, it's about ensuring meaningful communication. Here's how to get started:

## 1) Covert Scanned Text - (All tools > Scan and OCR)

Use the OCR tool to create "true text" so screen readers can read the text on screen.

## 2) Add Alt Text - (Prepare accessibility tool > Alt Text)

Provide descriptions for images, objects, and charts to communicate visual content to all users.

## 3) Check for Tags

Tags enable assistive technologies to read and interact with PDF documents. Headings (H1), paragraphs (P), and figures are examples of tag types. Check the tags pane to ensure there are tags, and, if not, add them.

## 4) Check for Reading Order

"Walk the tag tree." Review the order of the tags in the Tags Pane to ensure the correct reading order.

## 5) Artifact Tags

Artifacts are elements that are ignored by a screen reader, such as a background texture that does not contain important text. You can change an element to or from an artifact using the tag tree menu.

## 6) Set Title of Document (File > Document Properties)

Make sure the document has a title for the screen readers to read!

## 7) Run the Accessibility Checker under Prepare for Accessibility Tools

This built-in tool identifies common issues and offers fixes.

## ADA Quick Tips for Adobe PDFs

### Quick Tips to Make an Accessible Document

1 Covert scanned text – Under All Tools > Scan and OCR

2 Add alt text to images and objects – including charts!

3 Check for tags – Tag a document under Prepare for Accessibility tool

4 Check the Reading Order – Check under Tags Pane

5 Artifact Tags – A way to tell screen readers to skip past things, i.e. background textures that do not contain important text

6 Set the title of document – File > Document Properties

7 Use the Accessibility Checker – Under All Tools tab

# New Fire Apparatus at Station 7



Oconee County Fire Department had a “push-in” ceremony for the new Engine 701 at Station 7 in Bogart on August 14, 2025.

The fire department “push-in” ceremony, a tradition dating back centuries, symbolizes the formal entry of a new fire apparatus into service and honors the history of the fire service.

Engine 701 is a 2025 Sutphen custom cab engine, built in Columbus, Ohio. This state-of-the-art apparatus features a 1,000-gallon water tank and a 1,500 GPM pump, making it a reliable asset for emergency response. With seating for six, the custom cab is designed for both performance and crew comfort. The total investment of \$629,815 reflects our continued commitment to safety and efficiency.
